Proposed Sponsorship – RSPCA WA Million Paws Walk

We are bringing back the physical Million Paws Walk next year and we would like to apply for in-kind sponsorship from the Town of Victoria Park. The intended date of the walk is Sunday 28th May 2023.

The sponsorship proposal between the city and the RSPCA is to optimize responsible dog ownership/management in the local community, through a community event.

The event meets the Social, Economic, Environmental and Leadership values for the Town of Victoria Park by promoting a safe, connected, diverse, healthy event that provides a channel for a leadership voice for the Town to promote responsible pet ownership and support the functions of the local rangers with positive outcomes for all animals.

Does the sponsorship arrangement increase economic vibrancy by raising the profile of the Town? Recognition of the Town as a sponsor with logo placement on all promotional materials, including posters, flyers and RSPCA WA website.

The provision of a shared marquee with the City of South Perth (as per previous years). Historically this has been manned by the local Rangers to share important pet ownership messages with the walk audience.

The event provides an opportunity to showcase the Town's commitment to the community, positioning the Town as a premier place for entertainment and inclusivity.

There will be variety of different stall holders, vending and VIPs attending the walk, along with the participants which would include local residents. The provision of the shared marquee assists in providing the Town with a key presence at the event.
