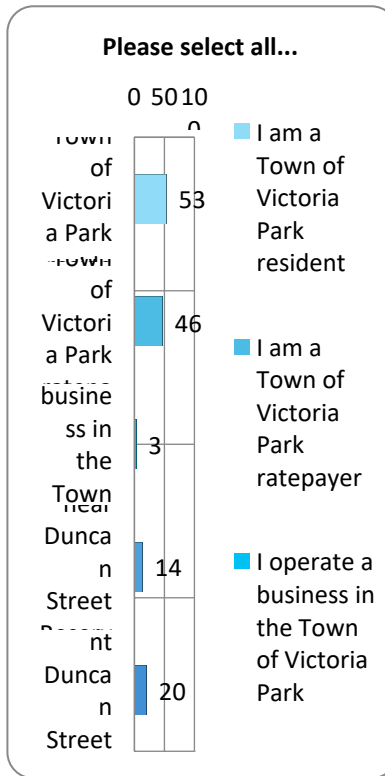

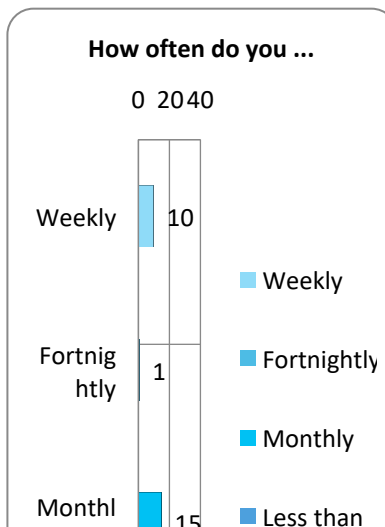

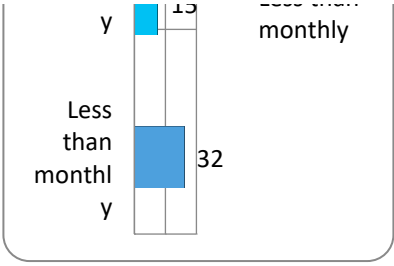

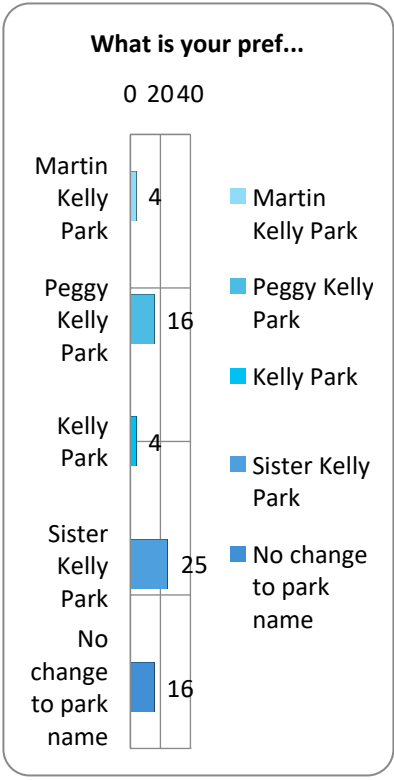

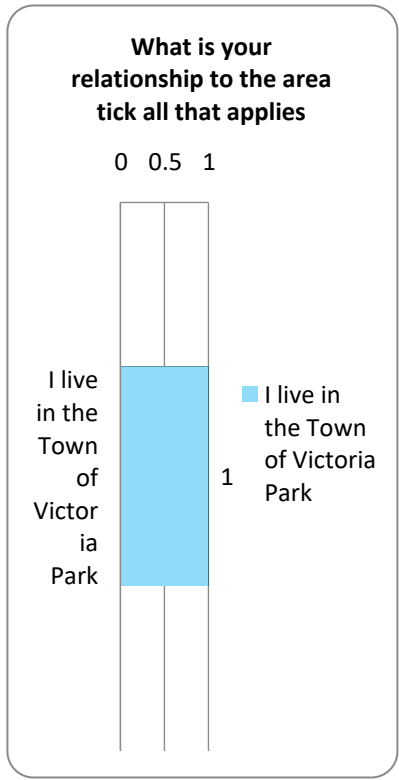

Do you have any other thoughts regarding the proposed name change?

I support the name change and to recognise Sister Kelly's contribution to Vic Park at a site local to where she once lived.

Lighten up this park also. Shade is required but can appear a bit dark at times and attracts people that stare at children

Although I am not a resident of Victoria park Sister Martin Kelly was my sister in law who I held in very high regard for her dedication to the wellbeing of children and ability to plan for the future for the needs of children

I used the park as a child and I remember the Kelly family who lived next to the park. My Aunty Sister Mary Michael was a nun at St Joachims with Mary Martin so I knew her quite well. I think naming the park in her honour is a wonderful tribute to an amazing woman.

We have lived in Duncan Street since 1986; our children grew up here, spending many happy hours at Duncan Street Reserve, as it's always been known. The Shire helped me plant a tree on Duncan Street Reserve in memory of my mother when she died. The reserve has a valued place in our lives.

In contrast, the school tends to overshadow the area already, e.g. it encroaches on residential areas by

Preferred name would be Sister Martin Kelly Park (or Sr Martin Kelly Park) as this more accurately reflects her name. I strongly support the renaming of Duncan Street Reserve as Sr Martin is my aunty. But more importantly her contribution to WA as a pioneer in child welfare, a woman recognised by the State and Church for her contribution to provide a better future for disadvantaged children and families, and her longstanding connection to Victoria Park, where she spent her formative years.

Attaching the word "Park" to the end sounds like it is her full name. You should consider keeping "Reserve" eg. Peggy Kelly Reserve, Sister Kelly Reserve. Park sounds like a surname. In keeping with this line of thought, my answer would be "Sister Kelly Reserve". Thank you.

Whilst I would prefer Sister Kelly Park, I would also be happy with Martin Kelly Park as they are both names that recognises the Sister's contribution.

Retaining name in reference to nearby street best outcome for way finding, and catholic namesake implies precinct and park belongs to near by catholic school, doesn't sound like shared, public open space or inclusive of the non catholic community in area.

I would prefer the Town to push for indigenous names instead. I am hesitant to support name changes associated with the Catholic Church given history continues to show many atrocities from their 'moral leaders' that have occurred in the past century. This is not directed at this specific individual at all for which the name change is being considered.

Sister Martin Kelly park preferred as that is who she was known as (full name and sister)

The only change that would make sense would be to name the reserve for its Aboriginal name. Do we know what that would be? Has the Mindeera Advisory Group been asked about this?

I wrote a submission in support of this proposal.

This suggestion from Historic Vic Park (the organisation) is in line with its objects and I, as a member, support the renaming.

I would like to defer to the family's preference . The name needs to be able to link back easily to the person. Nuns of that era would have been generally known as Sr Martin. I would prefer Sr Martin Kelly. Is there going to be a short biography attached

Women are the backbone of our community and yet miserably under represented in the naming of parks, street, pavilions etc. rename it as soon as possible and have this just a start thank you. Please do the name change soon.

We don't need a name change.

Councilors naming themselves after parks is not appropriate nowadays as councilors are getting paid for their work.

I think it appropriate to name the park after a passed resident of such high profile. A person who lived in the area and worked for improved quality of life for those in need.

I am fully supportive of the name change in recognition of the great humanitarian work done by Sr Peggy Kelly. Associating her work and MBE with Victoria Park in this way is good for the family and good for the Town. It is furthermore a very appropriate name for the park, as her family home was adjacent to it, and she probably used that land for recreation as children did in those days.. She also went to school nearby. Identifying those who do good work needs to be specific to the person in my view, , so Peggy Kelly Park is the most appropriate name.of those offered - in fact the only suitable name of those offered.

I oppose the change of name to Sister Kelly or any other of the suggestions above. I acknowledge that the Town seeks to improve recognition of women, however an indigenous name would be more appropriate in this circumstance. Sister Kelly has already been recognised by her MBE and she could be further recognised by the catholic church or Ursula Frayne school, which is also proximate to her childhood residence on Sunbury Road.

Our indigenous community members are significantly under represented and our recognition of country should extend to changing place names as occurred on the old bowling club site in Laithlain.

Before voting on a name change I would like to know how the Reserve was named Duncan Street Reserve Who is it named after and why?

Do not change the name of reserve. Suggest you can change the name of the street she lived on.

If you really need to change the name then it should be an indigenous name acknowledging the First Nations people of the area.

I think Vic Park council needs to seriously think before they rename the Duncan Street reserve. The park is used by the whole community which reflects a range of cultures and religions and should reflect this. Naming the reserve after one religish culture is an insult to all others. I'm sure the Sister was a 'good and worthy' person but with what as come to light in recent years of the Catholic church I feel this is dangerous choice

Sister Martin Kelly MBE was inducted into the WA Women's Hall of Fame when I was Minister for Women's Interests in 2016. A short biography of her contribution to the women and children of this state is available on the WA Women's Hall of Fame web-site, however it does not cover all of her contributions. To her family, friends and the women and children she helped, she was known as Sister Peggy, or Peggy Kelly. I think that this is an appropriate way for her to be remembered locally by the
