The fees for a speaker of this level are very high, generally over \$10,000. Salt's presentation was on the growth of Perth and the future of work and demographics. Attendees to this event paid \$50. Local Legends Business Breakfast with Ben Wyatt @ **Purpose** (Why and How) **Optus Stadium** Whv: To educate and build capacity of the business community To provide an environment for business networking To show support for the local business community To encourage connection with Optus Stadium. How: The Town would engage with the City of Canning to hold a "Local legends – Business Breakfast with Ben Wyatt" at Optus Stadium. The partnership approach would align to the previously planned Local Legends Sundowner, which was due in May, however cancelled due to human resourcing constraints at both LGA. Local legends are businesses that are longstanding within the Town and the City of Canning. Topic: How successful businesses have grown; and the impacts and opportunities resulting from the State Budget. Format- Q&A/ Interview Style. Phil Kemp, CEO from Business foundations, to MC and host the interview panel – 2 businesses from VP and 2 from Canning: Opportunity for LGA CEO's to be on the panel. Ben Wyatt to talk about what the government is doing for businesses in this area and a Q & A session on the State Budget. Cost It would be anticipated that the cost for this event would be for: Room hire at Optus stadium

A minimal fee could be charged to attract all types of businesses, such as \$20 per ticket. Total cost: approx. \$5,000-\$8,000.
