The Pop-up chat room will provide a central location for canvassing local people about the sorts of cycling education and training services that may be needed to help people build confidence and skills, as well as knowledge and attitudes needed to ensure safe riding. Experienced bike riders will share their own stories of lessons learned through their personal cycling journeys.

Local valunteers will focus on the local area by discussing best routes for each individual or family, ways to integrate bicycle use into daily routines and best bike styles for each person's capacity and needs.
