To the elected Members of the Town of Victoria Park

We would like to point out the disadvantages of the *Lagunaria Patersonii* tree. Our concerns centre around the health impacts upon residents.

1. The common name for this tree is the "Itchy Powder tree."
When the tree flowers, it then produces a pod with fibreglass-like "splinters" inside. The pods drop to the ground and open, releasing the "splinters". This material is highly irritating to the lungs while it is on the ground and the "splinters" inflame uncovered skin. They are extremely hard to remove as you can't see them.
2. Those suffering with asthma frequently have their condition aggravated by living near the above trees.
3. Children with a variety of allergies and asthma also have their conditions made worse by living near the trees.
