To identify the key areas the IWG see as priority in delivering the 2024 planting season and UF program.

DB: UF budget (\$380,000) for capital works has been allocated with the UF reserve funds available to make up the remaining to a full planting program.

ND: Are we seeing inflation impact what we can deliver?

DB: Some elements and materials we are seeing an increase of cost in the materials.

ND: Is the 5 year funding finite?

DD: We see the UF program as business as usual. The funding allocation ongoing is essentially the councils prerogative.

CR IFE: The motivation for funding UFS by council was committing to \$1mill to get the program off the ground not a finite contribution to the program.

RS: Are we happy to use the funds from reserves to make up the full program? No objections.

EM: Supports using the reserve funding and is aware the budget was going to be reduced but wants to support the budget doesn't get diminished over time. Would like it to be a strong program adequately funded by Vic Park.
