

## COMPLAINT ABOUT ALLEGED BREACH

### Code of conduct for council members, committee members and candidates

Schedule 1, Division 3 of the *Local Government (Model Code of Conduct) Regulations 2021*

This form should be completed, dated and signed by the person making a complaint of an alleged breach of the code of conduct. The complaint is to be specific about the alleged breach and include the relevant section/subsection in the code of conduct of the alleged breach.

The complaint must be made to the Behaviour Complaints officer within one month after the occurrence of the alleged breach.

The signed complaint form is to be forwarded to [admin@vicpark.wa.gov.au](mailto:admin@vicpark.wa.gov.au)

**NOTE:** A complaint about an alleged breach must be made —

- (a) in writing in the form approved by the local government
- (b) to the Behaviour Complaints Officer
- (c) within one month after the occurrence of the alleged breach.
